

EVACUATION READINESS

Pack your go bag before you need it. Be ready to leave on short notice.



MAKE PREPARATIONS

- Pack a go bag for every family member, including children
- Make a plan with your household and know who needs extra help
- Keep your vehicle fuelled and your phone charged
- Check on friends, family, and Elders
- Plan for your pets. They often cannot travel with you
- Stay informed through your First Nation's official channels

WHAT TO PACK

Identification & Documents

- ☐ Status card and healthcard for each person
- ☐ Picture ID and birth certificates
- ☐ Prescription list and medical information
- ☐ Family phone numbers written on paper
- ☐ Bank card and small amount of cash

Electronics & Essentials

- ☐ Cellphone, charger, and charging cables
- ☐ Portable power bank
- ☐ Flashlight and extra batteries
- ☐ N95 or medical masks
- ☐ Wallet and keys

Medications & Medical Supplies

- ☐ At least 7 days of prescription medications
- ☐ Glasses or contact lenses with supplies
- ☐ Mobility aids, CPAP, hearing aid batteries
- ☐ Medical equipment chargers
- ☐ Pain relievers and allergy medication

Food & Water

- ☐ Bottled water or a reusable water bottle
- ☐ Non-perishable snacks (granola bars, etc.)
- ☐ Baby food or formula (if needed)
- ☐ Special dietary foods

- ☐ Blanket or sleeping bag
- ☐ Comfort items for children
- ☐ Traditional medicines
- ☐ Pet supplies (if needed)

This is a general guide. Every household is different. Add the items your family needs to stay healthy and safe.

BEFORE YOU LEAVE

- Communicate with your community designate before leaving
- Take your go bag, medications, and documents
- Turn off appliances if instructed, and lock your home
- Register with evacuation staff and follow their instructions
- Let family know where you are going, if possible
